

IAH GRADUATE SUMMER FELLOWSHIPS

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

DEADLINE: MAY 1, 2018

PURPOSE: The Institute of Arts and Humanities (IAH) seeks to support completion of dissertations that relate to one of the following four themes.

1. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, with a particular focus on race, ethnicity, and social justice;
2. Global Arts and Humanities, with specific attention to linking investigation of seemingly disparate people and places across geographic, cultural, and chronological boundaries;
3. Public Arts and Humanities, with a special commitment to collaboration with local and regional libraries, museums, and community forums; and
4. Digital Arts and Humanities, with unique concentration on how new digital tools and technology can create and support new forms of research, pedagogy, and university/community interface.

ELIGIBILITY: Applications are invited from UCSD graduate students who will have advanced to candidacy by July 1, 2018. Terminal MFA students are also eligible.

AWARD AMOUNT: \$2,000. The timing and method of distribution will be determined after discussion with the student's home department.

AWARD PERIOD: Activities should take place in Summer 2018 (July 1–September 30, 2018).

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applications should be a maximum of two pages, 12-point font, single-spaced. References or images may be attached on additional pages. Applications should include the following:

1. Full name
2. Department
3. Dissertation project title and description
4. Description of activities to be supported (you may request support for travel, supplies, or equipment needed to complete research, or you may request support for your time to write the dissertation)
5. How the project relates to one of the four themes listed above
6. Simple budget

AWARD PROCESS: After the review committee has made its decision on the merits of the proposals, awardees will be notified in June. The IAH Business Office will coordinate with the student's home department to transfer the funds.

REPORTING PROCESS: Please submit a one-page report by September 30, 2018 describing progress on the proposed activities.
