### **CINE-BA-001**

#### **Program Learning Outcomes**

- Students will demonstrate an understanding of the fundamentals of making and analyzing the cinematic arts.
- Students will demonstrate a broad historical and critical understanding of cinema history, including trends in the US and internationally.
- Students will demonstrate proficiency in a range of production techniques including cinematography, editing, sound, animation, visual effects, directing, and presentation.
- Students will demonstrate a critical understanding of their own work as filmmakers and scholars and display the ability to write and speak about the themes and impact of their work.

#### **Assessment**

Student learning will be measured through multiple assessments (e.g. exams, presentations, papers, scholarly products, and project-based assignments). During the capstone course, students will be expected to complete a film or scholarly research project related to their area of study. The capstone is a primary vehicle to assess student learning in the program.

FILM 185 – Capstone: Provides students the time and direct guidance of an instructor to design, produce, and refine their own original work. This class is a culmination of the students' previous coursework. Students will synthesize their coursework into an original project of their own design, whether as a film production, research project, or community engagement project.
