

## AIP Undergraduate Scholarship Application Instructions Deadline: Rolling

Purpose: To support undergraduate students participating in an unpaid academic internship.

Eligibility: Undergraduate students with a declared major or minor in Arts & Humanities who have secured an academic internship through the UC San Diego Academic Internship Program (AIP), UC Washington Center (UCDC) or UC Center Sacramento programs, and the internship offers no compensation. Priority will be given to students whose internship connects with the disciplinary aims of the arts and humanities. Students who have received an award in the past may apply again, but preference will be given to first-time applicants. AIP has a minimum eligibility requirement of 90 units completed and a 2.5 UC GPA to access its internship portal.

**Award:** Up to \$1,000

**Application Process:** Submit the attached application form to <u>iah@ucsd.edu</u> before the start of your internship. Include the following:

- 1. Name
- 2. Major/Minor
- 3. Organization name
- 4. Copy of AIP Learning Agreement
- 5. Description (up to 250 words) of how this internship connects with the disciplinary aims of the arts and humanities and will enhance the student's education in one or more of the following areas:
  - a. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, with a focus on race, ethnicity, and social justice;
  - b. <u>Global Arts and Humanities</u>, linking investigation of seemingly disparate people and places across geographic, cultural, and chronological boundaries;
  - c. <u>Public Arts and Humanities</u>, with a commitment to collaboration with local and regional libraries, museums, and community forums; and
  - d. <u>Digital Arts and Humanities</u>, with concentration on how digital tools and technology can create and support research, pedagogy, and university/community interface.

Award Process: The student must notify IAH of the completion of the internship after grades have been posted. Scholarship funds will be disbursed after completion of the internship. Funds will be provided through the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office. All scholarships will first be applied towards the balance due to the university, if any, and only the difference will be issued to the student in the form of a refund. If the student is not enrolled in direct deposit the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office will mail a paper check to the address they have on file. All scholarships must be incorporated in the student's overall financial aid package. Generally speaking, when a student secures a scholarship it will first help reduce student work / student loan options before it could affect their grant aid.
