

Graduate Summer Fellowships Call for Applications Deadline: May 1

Purpose: The Institute of Arts and Humanities (IAH) seeks to support completion of dissertations that relate to one of the following four themes.

1. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, with a focus on race, ethnicity, and social justice;
2. Global Arts and Humanities, with attention to linking investigation of seemingly disparate people and places across geographic, cultural, and chronological boundaries;
3. Public Arts and Humanities, with a commitment to collaboration with local and regional libraries, museums, and community forums; and
4. Digital Arts and Humanities, with concentration on how digital tools and technology can create and support research, pedagogy, and university/community interface.

Eligibility: Applications are invited from UC San Diego graduate students in Arts and Humanities who will have advanced to candidacy by July 1. Terminal MFA students finishing their first year are eligible but PhD students will have priority. Students must be registered for the Spring or Fall, and not have reached their support limit.

Award Amount: Up to \$2,000. The timing and method of distribution will be determined after discussion with the student's home department.

Award Period: Activities should take place in the summer (late June-early September).

Application Process: Please complete the forms on the following pages. References or images may be attached on additional pages. Applications should include the following:

1. Full name
2. Department
3. Dissertation project title and description
4. Description of activities to be supported (you may request support for travel, supplies, or equipment needed to complete research, transcription or other assistance, or you may request support for your time to write the dissertation)
5. How the project relates to one of the four themes listed above
6. Simple budget
7. Information on whether/how you have participated in IAH activities over the last year
8. The names of other sources applied to for support and their status (awarded, pending, denied)

Award Process: Awardees will be notified in June. IAH will coordinate with the student's home department to transfer the funds.

Reporting Process: Please submit a one-page report by September 30 describing progress on the proposed activities.
