Collaboration and partnership are based on values including relationship-building, reciprocity, and mutual benefit.

Eligibility: Applications are invited from UC San Diego Senate and Non-Senate Faculty in the School of Arts and Humanities who will teach an undergraduate course. Associate-Instructors may apply, with preference given to faculty. Preference will be given to courses or experiences that fall under one of the following four themes.

1. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion, with a focus on race, ethnicity, and social justice;

2. Global Arts and Humanities, with attention to linking investigation of seemingly

disparate people and places across geographic, cultural, and chronological boundaries;

3. <u>Public Arts and Humanities</u>, with a commitment to collaboration with local and regional libraries, museums, and community forum.
